### Welwyn Track League.



BRRT rider Cody Nelson. Took 3 wins and a second place out of his 4 events at Gosling Velodrome last night. Riding his White Hinde with new Fast forward 80 mm rims and tubs at 145 psi, he dominated proceedings in his category (youth 1) against a strong field of 12 riders from all over the region.

In his first race, the 8 lap scratch, Cody raced intelligently, went from 300 metres chasing a solo attack, overhauled that rider by half way round the end banking, then rode away to take the win by 3 clear bike lengths.

In the final of the 4 up 500 sprint, Cody went high on the end banking, dived from station 4 and overtook Bennett from Welwyn just past the 200 metre line. He then showed his power by kicking again, to take the win most of the home straight in front.

After getting his breath back, he lined up on the fence for The Devil ( take the hindmost ) or elimination race if you've

only recently looked at track racing. Anyone who's ever raced a Devil will tell you it's evil ( and I've done them with 40 riders )

With twelve riders you've got a 9 lap high tempo race at just under 4 km with every lap ending in a hard sprint to avoid being last over the line and caught by the Devil. After 8 laps the four remaining riders took the bell and immediately turned it into a slow match sprint. The two Welwyn and one Verulam rider were keen to boss Cody up to the fence, but he held his ground and passed the solo attack just past the two hundred, again accelerating away to take an emphatic win.

Come the final event and it's fair to say that the 26 riders in the 10 lap youth 1 and 2 handicap were tired. Nonetheless, the youth 2 hares at point 3 set a blistering pace for the 1s off scratch to reel in. The 11 lads and one girl of youth one worked brilliant bit and bit for around half a lap each. Down to six riders by the catch at two laps to go, passing the Hares took the chase group half way round the last bend and they took the bell with four riders left. Cody and Joe Bennett ( Welwyn Wheelers) dropped the other two half way down the back straight. Bennett grabbed the sprinters lane, forcing Cody to come round the outside. The pair then had the most exciting gallop of the evening drawing the crowd to their feet. At the line, no one could visibly separate them so it went to a lengthy Photo finish discussion by all 4 Commissaires before Bennett was declared the winner by half a tyre.

Come and give track a go. You'll be hooked.
